## Instructions to candidates

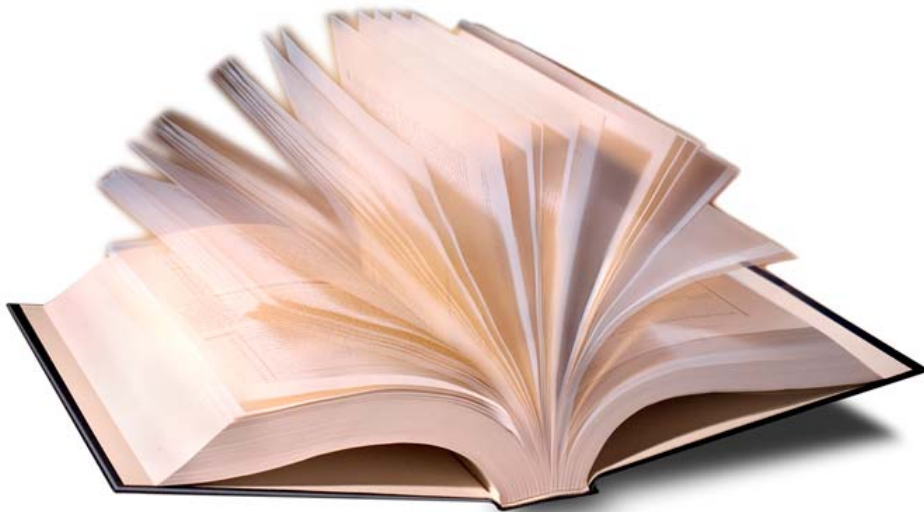


